

Volunteer Maryland 2016 – 2017 Service Sites

Allegany College of Maryland, in partnership with Garrett College and Frostburg State University, is founding a Volunteer Center to serve Western Maryland. To support these founding efforts, The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator with Allegany College of Maryland will recruit community volunteers to serve with several Allegany and Garrett County agencies. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator will work in close collaboration with staff at ACM, Garrett College and FSU, as well as with staff at partner agencies. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator will recruit 45 community volunteers who will engage in stewardship of public land, reading to kindergarten students, participation with local food drives and maintenance of a community garden. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator will use existing materials at Allegany College of Maryland as a basis for developing a wide range of volunteer program materials for the new Volunteer Center and its partner agencies.

Senior Legal Services (SLS) is a program of The Bar Association of Baltimore City and the **Baltimore Bar Foundation, Inc.** Founded in 1992 as Legal Services to the Elderly, SLS provides vital pro bono legal services to low-income seniors, aged 60 and over, in Baltimore City. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator (VMC) will work with staff to recruit, coordinate, and retain approximately 30 new volunteer attorneys who will represent clients in litigation or other legal services, visit senior centers and senior housing facilities each week, volunteer for the annual Law Day for Seniors held in April, and volunteer with quarterly estate planning clinics held throughout Baltimore City. The VMC will also develop a sustainable volunteer recruitment plan, add a screening component to the volunteer application and on-boarding process, and implement a volunteer recognition plan that acknowledges and rewards specific achievements.

The **Carroll County Forestry Board (CCFB)** promotes stewardship, conservation, and sustainable use of Carroll County's forest resources. CCFB has identified non-native invasive species as a serious threat to its mission. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator (VMC) will work with staff to help identify and train a single volunteer or group of corps volunteers who will assume responsibility for the Weed Warrior program. Beyond that central focus, the VMC will recruit 120 volunteers, including Weed Warriors, ecological field mapping volunteers, and native plant high tunnel caretakers to further CCFB's mission. In addition, the VMC will supervise volunteers on work days and lead volunteer events within Piney Run Nature Center. The VMC will also continue work on a wide range of volunteer program materials developed by previous VMCs.

Clifton Park Baptist Church Christian Academy provides innovative academic enrichment, leadership development, and recreational programs to underserved elementary, middle and high schools students. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator (VMC) will support the academic enrichment programs by recruiting and managing volunteers that will serve as enrichment instructors, tutors, develop curriculum which includes leadership development and co-curricular experiences and support and manage the Academy computer lab. The VMC will focus on recruiting from local colleges and community members and develop a strong recruitment plan. In addition, the VMC will work with program staff to implement a good support system for all volunteers.

The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator (VMC) will recruit and support volunteers that serve in multiple program areas. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator (VMC) will recruit and manage volunteers to serve as one-on-one mentors between children and youth experiencing homelessness and a positive adult role model. The VMC will implement a comprehensive volunteer recruitment and program supports which include policies and procedures, training and recognition of the volunteer.

Dundalk Renaissance Corporation's (DRC) mission is to mobilize stakeholders to invest in greater Dundalk's neighborhoods, economy and quality of life. As part of their current strategic planning process, they have identified a need in the community for the coordination of volunteers to connect older adults and low-income residents with services. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator will recruit 44 volunteers who will assist older adults and people with disabilities by performing home maintenance and repairs, providing transportation to appointments and events, and aiding access to food and health care. The VMC will also work with staff to co-manage volunteers, and will focus on volunteer placement, retention and recognition.

The Elms Environmental Education Center provides on-site, sequentially-developed, curriculum-integrated environmental education programs to 10,000 Pre-K-12 students annually from St. Mary's County public and private schools. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator (VMC) will work with the Native Plant Nursery program, and site-based and school-based environmental improvement and related instruction. The VMC will recruit 53 new volunteers who will assist education programs, maintain the Native Plant Demonstration Gardens and nursery, and maintain, restore and extend trails at the Elms. The VMC will also provide overall management of the volunteer program, and will further develop a wide range of volunteer program materials.

Habitat for Humanity of Wicomico County, Inc. is an ecumenical Christian housing ministry that builds, then sells homes to low-income families who, would never otherwise be able to achieve the dream of homeownership. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator (VMC) will recruit volunteers that will help with construction on Habitat houses. The VMC will also recruit and support volunteer that help with administrative support on a limited basis (no more than 10 percent of their total time). The VMC will consult with staff to implement a comprehensive volunteer recruitment plan and volunteer management system.

Hospice Caring provides caring, compassionate, practical and high-quality, non-medical support services, without charge, to Montgomery County adults and children facing a life-threatening illness or grieving the death of a loved one. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator (VMC) will directly recruit and support volunteers that will provide weekly visits of up to four hours to seniors who have a serious illness with no prospect of cure and need support at the end of their life. In addition the VMC will recruit volunteers that will support other programs within Hospice Caring and refer these volunteers to the appropriate staff person. The VMC will work with staff to update and revise volunteer program materials.

The Howard County Conservancy educates children and adults about our natural world and works to preserve the land and its legacy through responsible environmental stewardship. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator will recruit 118 volunteers who will serve as Naturalists, Stewardship Volunteers and Nature Center Greeters. The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator will also develop a wide range of volunteer program materials, including volunteer position descriptions, a volunteer program policy and procedure manual, volunteer recruitment materials, volunteer screening materials, volunteer orientation and training agendas, and a volunteer recognition plan.

The Volunteer Maryland Coordinator will also further develop and/or revise the volunteer program tracking system, volunteer applications, volunteer position descriptions, volunteer recruitment materials, volunteer screening materials, and volunteer orientation and training agendas.
